

## 800 SERIES PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these terms and conditions. Any entry not complying with these terms and conditions is invalid.
2. Entry is open to owners of buildings in New Zealand for whom PDL 800 Series Modena or Strato branded switchgear is purchased and installed for use throughout their building (or that portion of their building undergoing works) during the Promotional Period. In the case of corporate building owners, the owner must nominate an individual as the entrant for the purposes of the Promotion. Employees of the Promoter or its associated companies, employees of any agencies associated with this Promotion and the immediate families of any such employees are not eligible to enter.
3. The Promotion commences 1 March 2008 and concludes 31 August 2008 ('Promotional Period'). Entries will close 12 September 2008.
4. To enter, purchase and install PDL 800 Series Modena or Strato branded switch gear throughout your building (or that portion of it undergoing works) to the fullest extent practicable during the Promotional Period. Go to the entry form on-line at [www.pdl.co.nz/ultimatescape](http://www.pdl.co.nz/ultimatescape) and follow the prompts to complete your entry, including provision of details of building location and names of your key person electrical contractor and/or key person architect.
5. Only one entry is permitted per building project.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for submitting an entry, which is not in accordance with these conditions of entry.
7. The first valid entry drawn will win the Major Prize. Major Prize is a trip for up to 6 people over 18 years of age (building owner and guest, key person architect and guest and key person electrical contractor and guest) on a luxury charter – Ultimate Escape and includes return economy airfare to Tauranga from within New Zealand, airport transfers to and from luxury charter, one night's accommodation on board luxury charter in a twin share room and all meals. Flights and charter are subject to availability at time of booking. Additional spending money, transport to and from departure point to airport and other ancillary costs are the responsibility of the prize takers. Flights form part of the prize only to the extent that they are required or the prize taker to travel to Tauranga from the prize taker's primary residence. In the event of a dispute as to the correct identity of the key person architect or electrical contractor, the bona fide nomination on the entry form by the building owner shall be final.

Entrants agree to the use of their image and name for publicity regarding the Promotion and acknowledge that it is a condition of taking the prize that all persons taking the trip agree to publicity regarding the Promotion including the use of their names and images without additional compensation.

If for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned, whether caused by computer virus, line drop-out, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or another cause beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity of the Promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion (subject to any direction given by a relevant regulatory authority), to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion.
